Since the early nineties, Ruisinger has been working independently, focusing on portraiture, reportages and dance/performance, as well as interdisciplinary artistic projects. She uses photography, video, sound and text to strengthen the contents of her intentions. The main emphasis of her work has always been humans: imbedded in their vitality, impermanence and mortality. Her book *Faces of Photography* featuring 50 Masters of Photography, was published in 2002 and it received wide international acclaim, and her dance book *Meg Stuart/Anne Teresa de Keersmaeker*, featuring two of the world's most influential choreographers, was published in 2007. Her most recent work *Traces*, published in 2018, delves into the subject of loss and memories. She has been awarded numerous prizes and grants exhibiting in solo and collaborative shows, in Europe and abroad. Between 1998 and 2014 the collective *tm.woRK* with photography. Today besides her independent projects Ruisinger is realizing commissioned work, such as the Rolex Mentor and Protégé Arts Initiative. Since 2019 she is additionally focusing on visual storytelling and photo therapy in hospices, senior residences and nursing homes. She has a fixed pensum as phototherapist at Spital Zollikerberg and different other palliative institutions. Tina Ruisinger lives and works in Zurich and Berlin.
